

Announcement of Sainampeung School Regarding the Recruitment of a full-time foreign teacher

Sainampeung School is looking for qualified applicants to fill the position of a foreign English teacher, responsible for instructing Thai secondary students throughout the 2024 academic year. The following information is provided to aid interested candidates in their application process.

1. Job position

Foreign teacher

- English teacher 4 positions

Salary

32,000 – 45,000 THB

Contract duration

1st May 2024 - 31st March 2025

2. Qualifications

- 2.1 A bachelor's degree or higher in English, Education, or a related field.
- 2.2 Proficiency in the English language, both spoken and written. However, preference may be given to candidates with a strong command of English language skills.
- 2.3 Teaching license from the Teacher's council of Thailand or Khurusapha is preferable. Alternatively, applicants must have at least 2 years of teaching experience. Those employed by the school are expected to apply for a teaching license from Khurusapha.
- 2.4 Having teaching experience as an English teacher is preferable.
- 2.5 Good personalities with excellent communication skills.
- 2.6 Cultural sensitivity and the ability to adapt teaching methods to meet diverse student needs.

2.7 Applicants must achieve the minimum score in any one of the following English Proficiency tests:

TOEFL: A score of at least 500 (PBL) or 60 (iBT),

IELTS: An overall IELTS score of 6.5,

CU-TEP: A score of at least 75, and

TOEIC: A score of at least 750.

2.8 The original certificate of each document

3. Duties and Responsibilities

- 3.1 Work from 07.30 am to 04.30 pm from Monday to Friday.
- 3.2 Teach according to the school's schedule and regulations including some other responsibilities for not more than 24 periods/week.
- 3.3 Prepare lesson plans and supplemental materials that align with the educational institution's curriculum.
- 3.4 Act as an advisor to students in the assigned classroom in each academic year and take part in Parents Meeting event.
- 3.5 Organize and participate in activities that foster students' growth and abilities such as English Camps, Field Trips, and school events.
- 3.6 Available to fulfill additional tasks assigned by the school or foreign language department.

4. Required documents

- 4.1 Passport or ID card
- 4.2 Transcript and graduation certificate
- 4.3 English proficiency test result
- 4.4 2 photos (1.5" photograph taken within last 6 months)
- 4.5 A teaching license from the Teacher's Council of Thailand or Khurusapha, or a letter of recommendation regarding previous teaching experience from former school directors (if any).

- (2) Submit the required documents stated in No.4 (PDF file)
- (3) A video introducing yourself Duration: no longer than 5 minutes.
- (4) A video of a micro teaching demonstration (Topic depending on your preference but suitable for students in secondary school level)- Duration: 10 – 15 minutes.
- (5) Both videos must be in MP4 format
